Day 1:- Arrive Helsinki. Evening Free for Leisure.

(Dinner)

- Welcome to Helsinki. Upon arrival at Helsinki Airport, you will be transferred to Hotel.
- Arrive at the hotel and Check-in.
- Rest of the day is free for leisure.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Helsinki.

Day 2:- Guided City Tour of Tallinn. Evening back to Helsinki.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

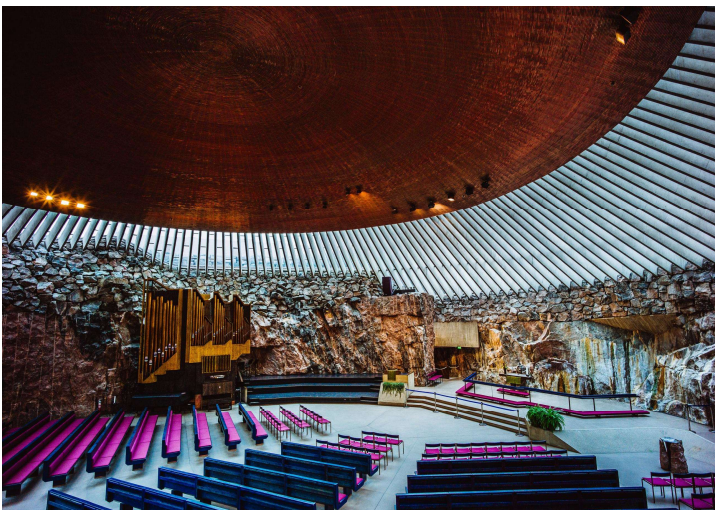
- After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed to Pier to board ferry to Tallinn.
- Arrive Tallinn and proceed with Guided City Tour of Tallinn.
- During the tour you will admire the Alexandre Nevski church and Dome church, and the 13th-14th century Danish-German castle, today the seat of the Estonian Parliament. There will be time for photo stops, and to take in the views of the medieval town-wall and its numerous towers. Then, stroll down to the lower part of the city: here you will find the Town Hall Square with the 15th century Town Hall, the 15th century pharmacy, and the buildings of the Great Guild and Brotherhood of Blackheads.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.



- After City Tour, proceed to Pier to board ferry back to Helsinki.
- Arrive Helsinki and Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Helsinki.

Day 3:- Guided City tour of Helsinki with Rock Church. Overnight Cruise to Stockholm. (Breakfast, Lunch & Local Dinner in Cruise)

- Today after breakfast, checkout from your Hotel and proceed for City Tour of Helsinki with Guide.
- We will start from the oldest neoclassical part of Helsinki and move forward to the modern functionalist center. We cover the main stories on politics, wars, economics and history in general that have shaped our country to what it is nowadays. Your Tour Includes the visit to Helsinki Cathedral, Senate Square Uspenski Cathedral, Market Square and Sebelius Monument.
- You will Visit Rock Church (Entrance Included). Tempeliaukio Church is a Lutheran church in the Töölö neighborhood of Helsinki. The church was designed by architects and brothers Timo and Tuomo Suomalainen and opened in 1969. Built directly into solid rock, it is also known as the Church of the Rock and Rock Church.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.



- Some free time and then we will proceed to Pier to board Siljaline Cruise to Stockholm. Check in the Cruise in **Oceanview Cabin** and enjoy all amenities which this overnight cruise has to offer.
- Scandinavian Buffet Dinner Onboard. **(Indian Dinner is not possible onboard cruise)**



- Overnight in Helsinki to Stockholm Siljaline Cruise.

**Day 4:- Arrive Stockholm. Guided City Tour of Stockholm with City Hall & Vasa Museum.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- Arrive Stockholm.
- After breakfast on board check out from the ferry & you will be transferred for City Tour of Stockholm with Guide.
- This is perhaps the most beautiful of the Scandinavian capitals, because the crystalline waters that flow through its intersecting canals give a luminous appearance to palaces, castles, and parks.
- The visit of Stockholm, a city often referred to as the Venice of the North, starts at Fjällgatan to see the magnificent view of the Swedish capital, spread out on 14 islands with Lake Mälaren on one side and the Baltic Sea on the other. You will see the Old Town with its fascinating, narrow cobble-stoned alleys, the Royal palace, the Cathedral, and City Hall, where the festivities of the annual Nobel Prize award take place. The visit will also take you to the recreational island Djurgården where many of the city's fine museums are found.
- We will also visit City Hall and Vasa Museum from inside during our City Tour.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- After lunch, continue with orientation and shopping tour of Stockholm with your Tour manager.



- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, Arrive at the hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Stockholm.

Day 5:- Depart Stockholm. Karlstad City Orientation Tour. Arrive Oslo.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Have hearty Scandinavian breakfast at your hotel.
- Check out from the hotel and proceed to Karlstad.
- Arrive Karlstad and lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, we will continue our two hours Orientation City Tour of Karlstad.
- Your Tour manager will show you beautiful city of Karlstad in this drive through tour with photo stop at Town Hall and Old City. It is a University city located in the rural centre of the country that also serves as the regional capital of Värmland county. It was founded by King Karl IX in 1584, and is sited on an island of the Klarälven river, and beside Europe's largest freshwater lake, Lake Vänern.



- After orientation tour, say good bye to Sweden and we enter Oslo, Capital of Norway.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Oslo.

Day 6:- Guided City Tour of Oslo with and Holmenkollen Ski Museum.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast, start a day with Guided City Tour of Oslo.
- Drive past by the Frogner park & Gustav Vigeland's sculptures also see the soaring City Hall, Karl Johans, Aker Brygge, Royal Palace, Astrup Fearnley Musuem, Akershis and Opera House.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Then Proceed for Hollmenkollen Ski Muesum.
- The Ski museum in Holmenkollen located underneath the famous ski jump, is the oldest of its kind in the world. The museum presents ore than 4,000 years of skiing history, Norwegian polar exploration artifacts and an exhibition on snowboarding and modern skiing. Incase museum is closed for renovation, we will just proceed to The observation deck on top of the jump tower which offers panoramic views of Oslo.



- Continue with Orientation and some free time to shop souvenir items.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Oslo.

Day 7:- Depart Oslo. Norway in Nutshell. Flam Line: Myrdal – Flam. Fjord Cruise: Flam – Gudvangen. Arrive Bergen.

(Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast, checkout from your Oslo hotel.
- Today we proceed for the most scenic sightseeing of Scandinavia. **Norway in Nutshell tour.**
- We will drive to Geilo and will board train from Geilo to Myrdal.
- Once we arrive at Myrdal, We will board Flam Line: Myrdal – Flam.

- The Flam Railway has been described as one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world and is one of the leading tourist attractions in Norway. The train runs from the end of Aurlandsfjord, a tributary of the Sognefjord, up to the high mountains at Myrdal station. The journey features the finest aspects of the stunning scenery of Western Norway.
- The Flam Railway is one of the steepest standard gauge railway lines in the world, with 80% of the journey running on a gradient of 5.5%. The train runs through spectacular scenery, alongside the Rallar Road, vertiginous mountainsides, foaming waterfalls, through 20 tunnels, and offers so many viewpoints that, for many people, a single trip up and down is not enough.
- **Packed Lunch will be provided on this day.**
- After lunch, Embark for a breathtaking FJORDS CRUISE (Flam – Gudvangen) on one of Norway's most mighty fjords. Today may well be the highlight of your journey.



- We will begin our fjord cruise from Flåm to Gudvangen. The vessel will begin its journey sailing through the idyllic Aurlandsfjord, which is also inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Furthermore, the boat continues through the narrow Nærøfjord before arriving Gudvangen, innermost in the Nærøfjord. The trip takes around two hours one way.
- On arrival at Gudvangen, we will continue to Bergen by Coach.
- Arrive Bergen and transfer for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, transfer to hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Bergen.

Day 8:- Guided City Tour of Bergen with Fløibanen Cable Car. Cider Farm Visit with Tasting. (Breakfast, Lunch, Wine Tasting & Dinner)

- After breakfast, get ready for the Guided City tour of Bergen.
- Built on seven hills with the fjords on one side and 1,000-foot Mount Fløyen on the other, Bergen was the home of composer Grieg. City tour takes in the main sights, including the Bryggen (Wharft), Haakon's Hall, Market Square, Bergen Cathedral, Fish Market, Bergenshus Castle.
- You will be taken for a ride on Fløibanen Cable Car. The Fløibanen funicular in Bergen is one of Norway's best-known attractions. Fløibanen can be found in the heart of Bergen, 150 m from Fisketorget – the fish market – and Bryggen wharf. It's only a 10-minute walk to the lower station from where the cruise ships dock. The journey up to Fløyen (320 m above sea level) takes about 5–8 minutes. The journey is an experience in itself, and at the top you can enjoy fantastic views of Bergen.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, proceed to Hardangerfjord.
- Experience local tastes and a magnificent fjord landscape on a cider tour to Hardanger! This tour includes several cider tastings in the Hardanger. During the tour, you will experience an orchard walk in Lofthus, visit the Norwegian cider champion Aga and learn more about cider and cider production in Norway. You will also be served tasting of Cider and that's an experience not to miss.
- Later back to Bergen and Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Bergen.

Day 9:- Depart Bergen / Arrive Stavanger. Overnight Fjordline Cruise to Hirtshals in Denmark. (Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner in Cruise)

- After breakfast, checkout from hotel.
- We will then proceed to Stavanger which is approx. 05 hours drive.
- **Lunch at Local Restaurant.**
- Post lunch, proceed to Pier to board Cruise to Hirtshals in Denmark. **Oceanview Cabin.**
- Scandinavian Buffet Dinner Onboard. **(Indian Dinner is not possible onboard cruise)**
- Overnight in Fjordsline Cruise.

Day 10:- Arrive Hirtshals / Transfer to Copenhagen. Evening Free for Leisure. (Breakfast, Local Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast onboard Cruise, get ready to checkout and proceed to Copenhagen.
- Arrive Hirtshals and board coach to Copenhagen.
- Enroute Lunch at Local Restaurant.
- Journey from Hirtshals to Copenhagen is scenic with full of natural beauty. In around 5 hours we reach Copenhagen.
- Arrive at Copenhagen hotel and Check-in.
- Evening free for leisure.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Copenhagen.

Day 11:- Guided City Tour of Copenhagen with visit to Tivoli Garden. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, get ready for Guided City Tour of Danish Capital of Copenhagen.
- Besides many interesting landmarks and architectural masterpieces, see some of the more famous sights during the tour. A typical city tour would take you past Tivoli, the Town Hall Square and the entrance to Strøget. You pass by Christiansborg Palace, which houses Folketing, the Parliament, as well as the

Queen's official reception rooms, the Prime Minister's office and the Supreme Court. A must-see is the Old Stock Exchange with its unusual tower with four dragons with their tails entwined. And of course, Nyhavn, the former sailors' area, where today you have a whole street of colorful old houses turned into restaurants and serving the well-known Danish lunch called smørrebrød.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, we will visit the Tivoli Garden with entrance included. Tivoli Gardens is an amusement park and pleasure garden in Copenhagen, Denmark. The park opened on 15 August 1843 and is the second-oldest operating amusement park in the world, after Dyrehavsbakken in nearby Klampenborg, also in Denmark.



- Later proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in Copenhagen.

Day 12:- Depart Copenhagen / Arrive Home.

(Breakfast)

- After breakfast, checkout and transfer to Airport for your flight back home collecting wonderful Memories & Souvenirs from your Scandinavia Holidays.
