Day 1:- Arrive Moscow Airport. Evening Moscow River Cruise.

(Dinner)

- Welcome to Moscow! Upon arrival at the airport, you'll meet n greet your local tour guide.
- Clear immigration and proceed to your hotel in Moscow.
- Arrive at hotel and check in.
- Later proceed for Evening Moscow River Cruise. Enjoy Moscow's majestic sights and landmarks by taking a scenic river cruise along the Moscow River, which is also known as Moskva River. Day 2:- Kremlin Territory with Cathedral Square, Moscow Red Square tour with St. Basil's Cathedral. Metro Tour and Arbat Street.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast, we will spend whole day visiting famous square and cathedrals of Moscow with a visit to Magnificent Red Square.
- Our first stop will be visit of Kremlin Territory and the Cathedral Square which is a breathtaking Architectural Ensemble of the 15th-17th centuries.
- The Moscow Kremlin, usually referred to as the Kremlin, is a fortified complex at the heart of Moscow, overlooking the Moskva River to the south, Saint Basil's Cathedral and Red Square to the east, and the Alexander Garden to the west. It is the best known of the Kremlins (Russian citadels) and includes five palaces, four cathedrals, and the enclosing Kremlin Wall with Kremlin towers. Also, within this complex is the Grand Kremlin Palace. The complex serves as the official residence of the President of the Russian Federation.





- This tour will cover your visit to few sights which are as iconic not only of Moscow and Red Square but indeed of Russia. St. Basil's Cathedral, whose colorful, onion-shaped domes are a symbol of the country around the world.
- Red Square and the Kremlin are both UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
- Post Lunch, later visit Metro Tour and Arbat Street.
- Metro With its underground network of trains and tunnels stretching for more than 190 miles (305 kilometers) across 200-plus stations, Moscow's metro system covers a lot of territory.
- Arbat Street mainly referred to in English as the Arbat, is a pedestrian street about one kilometer long in the historical centre of Moscow, Russia. The Arbat has existed since at least the 15th century, which makes it one of the oldest surviving streets of the Russian capital.





- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Moscow.

Day 3:- Depart Moscow / Tank Ride with AK-47 Shooting & Museum of Cosmonautics. / Arrive Murmansk.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Packed Dinner)

- After breakfast check out from hotel, we will proceed to most adventurous attraction of Moscow. Driving Army Tank and Shooting with AK47 Gun (This tour is for adults only and child can only do photoshoot)
- Once we arrive at location, will put on army-style clothing and jump into one of the Russian armoured vehicles still in use. You will be offered a weapon of your choice from a multitude of iconic Russian guns. Experience what it feels like to shoot a real AK-47, the original assault rifle and probably one of the most famous guns in the world, which has become a symbol of Russia.

Note: (Only Adults can do this. Child can do only photo shoot).





- Post Lunch, proceed for Museum of Cosmonautics.
- The Memorial Museum of Cosmonautics, also known as the Memorial Museum of Astronautics or Memorial Museum of Space Exploration, dedicated to space exploration. It is located within the base of the Monument to the Conquerors of Space in the north-east of the city.



- Later in the evening transfer to Airport to board flight to Murmansk.
- Packed Dinner will be provided today.
- Arrive Murmansk, Murmansk, known as the Russian Lapland- this city is in the extreme northwest of Russia and the world's largest city north of the Arctic Circle.
- Transfer to hotel and check in.
- Overnight in Murmansk.

Day 4: - Husky Farm and Saami Village with Aurora Borealis (Northern Lights) Tour. (Breakfast & Dinner)

- Today after Breakfast, proceed for Husky Farm and Saami Village Here, you will experience Saami culture where people still live as per the old traditions and rules which have very strong relationship with nature and wilderness.
- Later, visit Reindeer farm where you have an opportunity to feed them. we will take you on unforgettable experience to see the Siberian Husky dogs and enjoy a memorable Husky dog sleigh ride. Lunch at your own.





- Later City Tour of Murmansk with Ice Breaker Lenin.
- Dinner at Restaurant.
- Dinner and proceed for Aurora Borealis (Northern Lights Hunting Tour). The northern lights, or the aurora borealis, are the beautiful dancing waves of light that have captivated people for millennia. But for all its beauty, this spectacular light show is a rather violent event.

Day 5:- Teriberka Tour & Northern Lights Hunting Tour.

(Breakfast, Light Snacks & Dinner)

- After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for Teriberka Tour, Teriberka is a rural locality in Kolsky District of Murmansk Oblast, Russia, located on the Barents Sea coast, at the mouth of the river Teriberka. Teriberka is the last village on the Earth. It is 20 degrees off the North Pole. The Arctic winter is unforgiving and Polar Nights are unbelievably gloomy. It is minus 23 degrees Celsius.
- This trip involves picnic at Arctic Ocean Shore. Once in lifetime experience. Excursion to the Arctic Shore with Snowmobile Sledge. Visit Old wooden ships cemetery, waterfalls, Dragon Cave.
- Light snacks will be provided during tour.





- Dinner at Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, we will proceed for Aurora Borealis (Northern Lights Hunting Tour).



Overnight in Murmansk.

Day 6:- Depart Murmansk / Arrive St. Petersburg. Evening Free For Leisure.

(Breakfast & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to Murmansk Airport.
- Board Flight to St. Petersburg. Arrive St. Petersburg Airport and transfer to hotel, check in to hotel.
- Evening free for Leisure.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in St. Petersburg.

Day 7:- St. Petersburg City tour with entrance to Hermitage Museum.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

• After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed to explore the beautify city of St. Petersburg which is rightfully described as the Northern Venice or Pearl of the Baltic.

- Our city tour includes photostop at major places including but not limited to:
 - ✓ Kazan Cathedral
 - ✓ Fine Arts Square
 - ✓ Bronze Horseman Statue
- Arts Square is a testimony to the effectiveness of the originally planning that went into the city. The square's plan was drawn up by the Italian architect Carlo Rossi, who spent most of his life working in Russia and is considered by many to be a native Russian architect.
- Smolny Convent or Smolny Convent of the Resurrection, located on Ploschad Rastrelli, on the bank of the River Neva in Saint Petersburg, Russia, consists of a cathedral (sobor) and a complex of buildings surrounding it, originally intended for a convent.





Explore the Bronze Horseman, which is an equestrian statue of Peter the Great in Saint Petersburg, Russia. Commissioned by Catherine the Great, it was created by the French sculptor Etienne Maurice Falconet. The statue's pedestal is the enormous Thunder Stone, the largest stone ever moved by humans.





- Later you will be taken for lunch at Indian restaurant.
- Post Lunch we will continue with our visit to the State Hermitage Museum. It is a museum of art and culture in St. Petersburg, Russia. One of the largest and oldest museums in the world, it was founded in 1764 by Catherine the Great and has been open to the public since 1852.





- Evening free for some souvenir shopping and then we head for Dinner at Indian restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in St. Petersburg.

Day 8:- Visit Peterhoff Park with Grand Palace. Shopping at Nevsky Street / Galleria Mall. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready to be amazed by the Palace of Versailles of Russia.
- Peterhoff Park is designed at the request of Peter the Great to rival Versailles Palace of Paris.
- After a 22 mile drive through the suburbs of St Petersburg, we reach Peterhoff.
- The place includes:
- The Grand Palace. It is located in the heart of Peterhoff. It was the former summer residence of the Russian Czars. It rises above the so-called Grand Cascade and the park below.
- Other palaces and museums. Throughout the Peterhof complex there are many other small buildings, museums or churches, such as the Palace of Farmers, Marly Palace, the Cottage Palace, Church Wing, The Museum of Collections, The Museum of Playing Cards, etc.
- In the Lower Park, you will find the various palaces and buildings, as well as the complex of the world's largest fountains. It covers an area of over 100 hectares. The water sources used comes from natural springs. Along the Lower Park there are many fountains and waterfalls, such as the Great waterfall and Samson's fountain. There are also many playful fountains for the children to play.
- After the fun filled trip to Peterhoff Park, Post Lunch, After visit Peter and Paul Fortress. The Peter and Paul Fortress is the original citadel of St. Petersburg, Russia, founded by Peter the Great in 1703 and built to Domenico Trezzini's designs from 1706 to 1740 as a star fortress. Between the first half of 1700s and early 1920s it served as a prison for political criminals. It has been a museum since 1924.





- Return back to the city and free time for some last-minute shopping.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in St. Petersburg.

Day 9: - Depart St. Petersburg / Arrive Moscow in Sapsan Train. Evening Moscow Circus. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Today after Breakfast, checkout and transfer to St. Petersburg train station to board high speed Sapsan train to Moscow. Arrive Moscow Train Station, Have Lunch at Indian Restaurant and transfer to hotel.
- Check into hotel.
- In the evening, get ready to be amazed by Extravagant Moscow Circus.
- The Moscow Circus is one of the most grandiose historical constructions of the modern century, which was erected as far back as the end of the 19th century and continues to thrive to this day. This is an amazing place for spectacular performances, where outstanding people and skilled craftsmen from all over Russia gathered: artists, equilibrists, trainers, jugglers, kings of laughter, clowns and many other talented talents! Fascinatingly well-coordinated work of circus artists, like a beautiful song, captivates the audience, inspiring a sense of respect for human labor. After the circus performance they take with them a sense of joy, faith in the strength of man, in his boundless possibilities.
